# DAY WISE ITINERARY

## DAY-1

### CHANDIGARH TO MANALI

Arrive Chandigarh meet our representative and proceed to Manali. Overnight Journey.

## DAY-2

### ARRIVAL IN MANALI

Reach Manali early in the morning, complete the check-in formalities and have a breakfast. After resting for a while, it's time to head towards Manali for local sightseeing. Visit Hadimba Mata Temple, Vashisth Kund and enjoy evening in the Mall Road. Return back to the hotel, dinner and overnight stay.

## DAY-3

### MANALI TO KAZA VIA KUNZUM PASS

After breakfast, proceed towards Kaza. You will be passing through the popular Atal Tunnel. At 14,931 feet, you will be catching your first chill at the Kunzum Pass and then descend into Losar Village, the first village in Spiti valley. Reach Kaza, fresh up and have dinner. Overnight stay at hotel.

## DAY-4

### KAZA - KOMIK - HIKKIM - LANGZA

After breakfast proceed for KAZA Sightseeing. First, you will be visiting the highest village in Asia, Komik. You will then proceed to Hikkim for a visit to the world's highest post office in the world. After that you will be driving to Langza, a village that is home to the ancient Lang Temple. You will then be proceeding towards the world-famous Keyy Monastery, Kibber village, from Kibber, you will drive higher up to the secluded village of Gette where you can absorb stunning aerial views of Kaza and tie a prayer flag. Later in the evening, you will drive back to Kaza to spend the night at the hotel.



## DAY-5

### EXCURSION TO TABO WITH DHANKAR

After breakfast, proceed towards Tabo Sightseeing. At Tabo, visit the 1020-year-old Tabo Monastery which is a UNESCO world heritage site. After spending a couple of hours at Tabo, visit Dhankar Lake and Pin River. If time permits, do take an hour's climb above the village to visit the stunning turquoise Dhankar Tso or Dhankar Lake. You will be first visiting the Kungri Monastery and then the beautiful hamlet of Mudh, which is the last motorable village of the Pin Valley. You will then drive back to Kaza in the evening to spend the night at the hotel.

## DAY-6

### KAZA TO CHANDRATAL LAKE VIA KUNZUM LA

After breakfast, proceed to Chandratat. However, on your way back you will take a detour towards another Spitian wonder, Chandratat Lake. The mystical and beautiful Chandratat Lake, with a striking backdrop of Chandra Bhaga mountain range, keeps changing its appearance throughout the day. After capturing the colors of the beautiful Chandratat Lake, you will drive down to your campsite where you can enjoy a hot supper under the gaze of a million stars. Overnight stay at the camps near Chandratat Lake

## DAY-7

### CHANDRATAL LAKE TO MANALI VIA ROHTANG

After breakfast proceed towards Manali. You will pass through the newly built Atal Tunnel to reach Manali where you can choose to explore the markets shopping for souvenirs. Later in the day, you will head to Manali Bus Stand to board a bus to Delhi. Overnight Journey in Bus.

## DAY-8

### REACH CHANDIGARH (DEPARTURE)

In the morning reach Chandigarh. Tour conclude with sweet memories.
