



We will not be responsible for any reimbursement, damages, substantial loss, or other expenses if you cancel the booking.
- To cancel your booking, you must inform us in writing.
 Notification is deemed given on the date of receipt of your letter/request.
- The following cancellation charges shall be applicable, regardless of the reason for cancellation.
- It is understood and acknowledged that these charges represent a genuine prestimate of the damages we would incur due to cancellation. Referred to as liquidated damages in legal terms, they are payable without the requirement for proof of actual damages. Your agreement not to dispute such deductions or demand proof of actual damages is hereby acknowledged.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Rates: Rates are valid only for Indian Nationals, for any other nationality, please speak to our Travel Experts.
- International Check in Time: 1500 Hrs & Check Out Time -1100 Hrs
- Passport Validity: 06 Month from the Arrival Date (Rest of the World). For Malaysia - 09 Months from the Arrival Date Full Payment
- Exchange Rates: All international group tours are priced on an estimated Rate of Exchange (ROE). The passenger will be charged the ROE as per the date of payment of the holiday package.
- Payment Policy Changes: The above payment policy is subject to change during peak seasons
- Hotel Room Conditions: Hotel rooms may not be air conditioned / air cooled nor will fans be provided. Air conditioning / cooling in hotels are set as per European weather conditions. Functioning of Air cooling / Air conditioning in hotels is subject to official declaration of summer by the local authority. During heat wave in Europe air conditioning of the hotels and coaches may cease to function as they are not built for such high temperatures. Most hotels in Europe do not provide tea kettles in the rooms.
- Hotel Locations during Events: Due to international events and trade fairs all throughout Europe (such as the Air Show, music festivals, ice skating championships etc.,) you may have to stay in hotels further away from the city.

- All itinerary rates are based on departures from Mumbai. Prices may vary for departures from other cities. The price is calculated at an exchange rate of ₹90. However, INR payments for the foreign exchange component will be calculated based on the prevailing ROE on the day of payment.
- In a twin-sharing arrangement, if one individual's visa is rejected, the other person must proceed with single occupancy and bear the associated cost (Single Supplement).
- A person below 12 years of age throughout the tour will be considered a child.
- As a 3rd person in a triple room, most hotels use rollaway beds, and the room size may be the same as the double room.
- Tours will operate subject to all government regulations.
- Local taxes, entrances, and services are calculated as of October 1, 2023.
 Any increase in local taxes, entry tickets, and other services must be borne and paid by the traveler.
- All transfers and extensive sightseeing with entrance fees (as specified in the itinerary) will be done in an air-conditioned coach.
- If there is a long queue at the Eiffel Tower, you may be taken to the Montparnasse Tower.
- It is suggested to carry one check-in bag and one handbag per person due to limited boot space in the coach.
- On some occasions, you may have to join another group if your group does not have adequate members.
- Land surcharges are applicable on certain departure dates, which will be notified.
- If certain sightseeing/excursions are closed, alternate arrangements will be made.
- The tour routing could change on certain departure dates, and there is a
